DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

Shirts/Blouses		Pants/Skirts/Shorts	
Polo Shirts, Oxford Shirts (either buttoned all the way or unbuttoned with a solid t-shirt underneath), Henleys, turtle necks, sweaters and blouses.		Trousers/Jean/Pants/Cargos/Shorts Must Be In Good Repair (no rips, holes or frays; decorative fray around the ankles is allowed)	
Solid colors, stripes or appropriate patterns allowed		No sweatpants, basketball shorts, sleepwear, or athletic wear	
Though small logos are permissible, no other wording or images are allowed		Girls may also wear skirts, skorts, or dresses	
<i>Must have sleeves that fully cover the shoulder at all times</i>		Leggings may only be worn under a skirt or dress or shorts

Solid Sweatshirts, Jackets, and Hoodies (hood down)		Tennis Shoes, Sandals, Dress Shoes

Hair/Make-up		Accessories	
Natural hair colors only		<i>No visible tattoos or body art (permanent, semi-permanent or temporary)</i>	
Clean Shaven at all times		Some modest jewelry is permitted	
Hair should be neatly kept and styled (no distracting styles)		For girls, one pair of earrings is permitted	
For girls, light and modest make-up is permitted		Avoid excessive or distracting jewelry	
		<i>Hats, hoods, sunglasses or anything else that covers the head or face are not allowed to be worn in the building</i>	

LPA Thursdays/Fridays - Students may wear any LPA clothing as long as it follows the modesty standards

The italicized guidelines apply at all school events and activities whether school is in session or not
