- Liahona has always believed in and practiced the importance of small class sizes. We will continue the school year with this in mind. Though our classrooms are small, this summer we are planning on removing unnecessary and excess furniture in the rooms so that students will have more space around their desks and won't be as tight. We anticipate that desks will be 3-6 feet apart depending on the classroom.
- We will teach good hand hygiene while providing hand sanitizer in every classroom and encouraging frequent hand washing especially when using the restroom, going to lunch, leaving the classroom, first entering the classroom in the morning, or using shared classroom supplies.
- Liahona has always had students go to lunch and recess one class at a time. This will continue without change.
- Our cleaners will be trained in a more thorough disinfecting process to be used on a daily basis.
- Masks will be optional. We have had parents reach out to us concerned that their children may be teased or singled out for wearing a mask or not wearing a mask. Liahona has always been a safe space from bullying and we have full faith in our students and staff that in whatever situation, love and safety will always be the prominent feeling at Liahona.
- If a student, teacher or staff member has a fever or is showing symptoms of being sick, especially with symptoms of Covid-19, we ask that you stay home. We are blessed at Liahona that students 7th grade and up can simply watch their classes from home in this situation and that we have such amazing elementary teachers that will help our younger students through constant communication.
- Students, Teachers and Staff should all check their temperatures at home before coming to school in the morning. Individuals with a temperature of 100.5 or higher should stay home and let the front office know. Temperatures will not be taken at the school.

2. *Maintain a mostly normal experience for the students where the teachings of the Holy Ghost can continue to thrive.*
